- Implement Treatment and behavior plans written by the BCBA
- Collect data on acquisition, maintenance, and behavior goals
- Collaborate with members of each specific client's team
- Some of the activities we teach include: communication, social, , motor, self-care, school readiness, and self-management, academic, floor play, associative play, turn taking, toilet training, play, hygiene routines, community outings, preschool skills
